


DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT AND THE CONTENT




WHATIS ERASMUS+



Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe. It supports the European Pillar of Social Rights, implements the EU Youth Strategy 2019-2027 develops the European dimension in sport.

It has an estimated budget of €26.2 billion.

This is nearly double the funding compared to its predecessor programme (2014-2020).
